Because of God working through us, we have reached thousands of people in our community and missions around the world.


As a church, we continually strive to lead more people to Jesus, and grow the kingdom.

WHAT CAN I DO TO HELP WITH THE KINGDOM PROJECT?


- Listen to the Kingdom Sermon Series and study the scripture outlined in the series

Why do we need more space?
What steps have we taken already?
On March 4, 2012, we added a second service to accommodate our growing numbers. The church building is used during the week by many community organizations. We often have to turn away local organizations because the building is already scheduled.
In 2016, we added a third service due to increased growth and limited space. We also removed walls between classrooms to allow for larger class sizes.

The youth group moved their meetings from the church to the "Porter House," the building once used as the church parsonage. We added a mid-week service on Thursday nights at 7 pm. All of these things were done to help with the space issue during worship services. We are still finding it difficult to schedule events and classes during the week and on Sundays. That brings us to today, how can we continue to grow the Kingdom with limited resources? The best answer is "The Kingdom Project," which will add a new sanctuary, classrooms, offices, and a larger lobby with seating and a café. The existing sanctuary and office complex will be utilized as the future Children's ministry area.
