Signing Up: You can sign up for events online, through the office and at the registration table in the lobby. All events have a beginning and end registration date. Some are much earlier than the actual event date because of when payments are due.

Payments: You can pay by using the BLACK BOX in the lobby next to the registration table. There are envelopes to indicate which event you are registering for. Make sure the envelope is marked for the proper event. Please DO NOT put your payments in the offering boxes, as they could be mistaken for a general offering. You may also drop payments off at the office between 8a and 4p, Monday – Friday.

Many times our payments are due 30 days before the actual event date. So please make your payments when you register for a particular event.

Changes to the event: Vendors have the right to change or adjust our event times. Because payments are due so early for some events, we may not be able to offer refunds once the payment has been submitted. Please pay attention to the announcements so if anything changes you will be aware of it.

Lancaster Overnighter: Please notice: if you plan on attending the "Noah" trip, the deadline for registering is in June. This is 2 months before the actual event. There is an example of a payment schedule for the fee listed in the information packet, as well as FCCM's overnight policy. Mark your calendars with these important dates.





ADULT MINISTRY POLICY OVERNIGHT OUTINGS APPROVED 4/13/2023

It is the policy of this ministry to adhere and promote Christian morality in all the events of the Adult Ministry. We are living in confusing times of morality. It is the word of God that brings clarity and direction to our lives. Therefore, the following policies have been written down to prevent any confusion with our overnight outings. These were taken from "What We Believe" Statement on Marriage Gender and Sexuality Section III D-2.

1. We believe that "marriage" has only one meaning; the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture. (Genesis 2:18-25). We believe that God intends sexuality intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other. (1Cor.6:18; 7:2-5; Heb 13:4 Matt. 15:18-20; 1 Cor. 6:9-10). We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexuality be engaged outside of a marriage between man and a woman.

We believe that every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity. Hateful and harassing behavior or attitudes directed toward any individual are to be repudiated and are not in accord with Scripture nor the doctrines of FCCM.

In our belief section (Section III D1), it is stated about Human Beings:
Human beings were created by God to walk in fellowship with Him. However, all (except Jesus) have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Rom. 3:23), and must rely on God's grace and forgiveness. Every human from the moment of the conception of life is in the image of God (imago deo), a person to be nurtured, protected, and developed.

God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God (Gen. 1:26-27).

Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person.

As a result of these beliefs and convictions we conclude:

2. If a couple is not married, they are welcome to attend our overnight events as long as they do not room together.

We strive to be as close to these qualifications as possible and we hope that this helps bring clarity to our outings and events.

Currently, our church only recognizes marriages between a male and female by the State. We ask those who were married without a State approved license not room together.
